All students will work on an individual project within a small team. We will form teams of 3 students, each followed by 2 tutors. Each team will be working on an assigned topic within the below listed ones.

- Laser Scanner digital survey of the Kyrenia Castle, under the direction of the Laboratory of the University of Florence.
- Photographic digital survey of the Kyrenia Castle, under the direction of the Laboratory of the University of Florence.
- Photogrammetric digital survey of spolia and archaeological fragments in the castle. Coordinated by the Department of History, Restoration and Survey of Sapienza University of Rome.
- Documentation of the archaeological materials in the deposits of the Department of Antiquities, connected to the Kyrenia Shipwreck, Coordinated by the Department of Antiquities and Museums.
- Documentation of masonry types and mortars, Coordinated by the Scuola di Specializzazione in Beni Architettonici e del Paesaggio, "Sapienza", University of Rome
- Design of an Archaeological museum inside the Kyrenia Castle, Coordinated by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Alessandro Camiz and Assist. Prof. Dr. Zeynep Ceylanli
